(NEW ORLEANS, LA) – The Junior League of New Orleans (JLNO) announced that The Helis Foundation awarded a grant to the organization’s Diaper Bank program, which serves needy families across the Greater New Orleans Area.

“We are deeply grateful to The Helis Foundation for its generosity to the Junior League of New Orleans,” JLNO President Alice Glenn said. “With their help, JLNO purchased 83,000 diapers that will go to the one in three parents in our area who struggle with providing diapers for their children.”
