THE JUNIOR LEAGUE OF NEW ORLEANS OPENS APPLICATIONS FOR 2022-2023 COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE FUND GRANTS

The Junior League of New Orleans (JLNO) is pleased to announce the opening of applications for its Community Assistance Fund (CAF) program. The CAF program provides JLNO with a flexible means to grant money to nonprofit agencies who can effectively demonstrate a need for funding and who seek to advance the wellbeing of women.

Junior League of New Orleans President, Holly Paczak, expressed her pride in the CAF programs' legacy saying, " JLNO is proud to support other nonprofit organizations through their Community Assistance Fund who also champion our mission of developing the potential of women with a focus on improving their economic, physical and familial support systems." Since 2011, the Junior League of New Orleans has awarded over \$300,000 in CAF grants to local area nonprofits.

Community Assistance Fund grants are awarded annually to organizations whose programming addresses one or more of the following areas of community need:

- Economic Opportunity – Supporting women’s potential to seize economic opportunities
- Physical and Mental Health – Improving women’s health, allowing them to live healthy and happy lives
- Family Assistance – Providing needed family support to alleviate the burdens on women caregivers

Past CAF grant recipients include: The 18th Ward, Mercy Endeavors, Son of a Saint, Kid SmART, ArcGNO, YMCA of Greater New Orleans, Catholic Charities, Silence IS Violence, Second Harvest Food Bank of Greater New Orleans, and Luke’s House: A Clinic for Healing and Hope.
