Diaper need is the lack of a sufficient supply of diapers to keep an infant or toddler clean, dry, and healthy.

1 IN 3  moms struggle with diaper need

6 TO 10  diapers needed each day per baby

\$100  a month needed to buy diapers



Diaper need has adverse health affects on families, including rashes and urinary tract infections for children along with stress, anxiety, and depression for parents.

Without diapers, babies cannot attend childcare or early education programs.



Without childcare, parents cannot go to school or work to further provide for their families.
