## Junior League of New Orleans hosts diaper drive during National Diaper Need Awareness Week

47% of families struggle to afford diapers

**WHO:** Junior League of New Orleans (JLNO)

**WHAT:** Public diaper drive to support 47% of families that struggle to afford

diapers in support of Diaper Need Awareness Week Sept. 18 – 24.

WHEN: Wednesday, Sept. 20

10 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

WHERE: 4319 Carondelet St., New Orleans, LA 70115

**HOW:** New or opened boxes of diapers can be dropped off to JLNO

headquarters from 10 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monetary donations can be made

at ilno.org/donate.

**WHY:** Diapers can cost up to \$100 per month, and babies need six to ten

diapers per day. Despite the expense and need, no direct government assistance is available for diapers. Yet almost one in two families in the U.S. struggle with diaper need. According to a recent survey by the

National Diaper Bank Network:

• 47% reported struggling to provide children with clean, dry diapers.

- 46% reported reducing other expenditures to afford diapers.
- 53% said they felt judged as a bad parent/caregiver because they could not afford diapers.

- 25% of parents and caregivers with diaper need reported having to miss work or school because they did not have enough diapers to drop their child off at childcare, and reported missing, on average, 5.1 workdays in the past 30 days.
- This represents a loss of \$296 per month for a parent earning the federal minimum wage of \$7.25 per hour.
