JLNO'S 'BUY, SAVE AND SERVE' SUPPORTS BUSINESSES AND COMMUNITY

Sept. 29, 2014, New Orleans, LA – Want great deals, while helping local businesses and the community? The Junior League of New Orleans (JLNO) invites everyone to join in its eighth annual Buy, Save and Serve event.

For a \$35 donation to JLNO, each donor receives a savings card. On Nov. 1-11, cardholders may present the card at participating New Orleans-area businesses and receive up to 20% off their products or services.

More than 900 cardholders contributed to last year's event, which raised more than \$35,000. Proceeds benefit JLNO's many community projects.

This year, more than 175 local businesses are participating, including restaurants; B&Bs; salons; clothing boutiques; jewelers; and medical, legal and financial service providers. Of these businesses, 85 are women-owned, 10 are minority-owned and three are veteran-owned.

"I'm always impressed by the number of New Orleans merchants that support the work of the Junior League by offering a discount through the Buy, Save and Serve card," says JLNO President Katherine Kleinpeter Raymond. "These retailers directly help us to advance the well-being of women through programs such as Safe Sitter, Rebuilding Together, Judgment Call and our new Diaper Bank, an initiative to support mothers struggling to provide their babies with clean, dry diapers. I'm proud to live in a city that works together to help the community."
